



# BOWSHIEL FARM

## Viewpoint 1 A1/A1107 Junction

**Existing View**  
This view looks south along the A1 which is seen extending away along the valley of the Pease Burn. Low hills frame the valley, with commercial forestry and open fields seen over the hills to the left of the road, with a wind turbine seen turning just above, and the hills to the right a mix of scrubby groundcover and recently felled forestry beyond roadside trees. Looking across the road to the west there is a series of houses seen above a large retaining wall beside the road and to the left of these a quarry is seen cutting into the nearby hills. Looking north, away from the Application Site, the view is focussed on the road and the vegetated embankments to either side with a glimpse of the sea in the distance.

**Predicted Changes to Views**  
During early operation, the near edge of solar panels would be seen along the skyline above the recently felled forestry and just to the left of this. Looking along the road, a further small area of solar panels would be seen more distantly in open fields that drop down the valley side towards the road. Once proposed mitigation planting matures, the nearer panels on the skyline would be largely screened beyond new hedges but the more distant area of solar panels would remain visible.

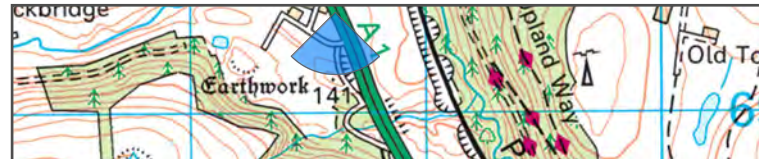
